

**MINUTES OF THE  
TOWN COUNCIL  
APRIL 27, 2009**

**ITEM 1 CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Vardell called the regular session to order at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, April 27, 2009, in the Vivian Cockburn Municipal Building located at 405 Shaffner Street.

**ITEM 2 ROLL CALL**

Those present were Council Member Ashman, Council Member Rouse, Mayor Pro-Tem Gorman and Mayor Vardell.

**ITEM 3 INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG**

Police Chief Steve Grube led the invocation and pledge of allegiance to the flag.

**ITEM 4 MAYOR'S REPORT**

**ITEM 5 CITIZEN INPUT**

No one signed up to speak.

**ITEM 6 CONSENT AGENDA.**

Mayor Pro-Tem Gorman moved to approve the March 23, 2009 minutes, the March bill report and the March financial statement. Motion seconded by Council Member Ashman. Ayes: Council Member Ashman, Mayor Pro-Tem Gorman and Council Member Rouse. Nays: None. Abstentions: None. Motion passed with 3 ayes, 0 nays and 0 abstentions.

**ITEM 7 CONSIDER AND ACT ON APPROVAL OF FUNDS FOR ELECTRICAL WIRING FOR THE LIFT STATIONS.**

Director of Public Works Gary Morris presented the Council with a bid for installing the electrical wiring necessary for the lift station generators. Mayor Vardell asked that Gary seek bids from other local electrical companies before proceeding. Mr. Morris noted that these funds will come from the Emergency Repair Fund and will have no budget impact.

Mayor Pro-Tem Gorman moved that Gary Morris seek additional bids, approve and proceed with the work without further action from the Council. Motion seconded by Council Member Ashman. Ayes: Council Member Ashman, Mayor Pro-Tem Gorman and Council Member Rouse. Nays: None. Abstentions: None. Motion passed with 3 ayes, 0 nays and 0 abstentions.

**ITEM 8 CONSIDER AND ACT ON A PROCLAMATION, PROCLAIMING APRIL 27, 2009 AS PONDER LIONS BASKETBALL DAY IN THE TOWN OF PONDER.**

Council Member Ashman moved to proclaim April 27, 2009 as Ponder Lions Basketball Day in the Town of Ponder. Motion seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Gorman. Ayes: Council Member Ashman, Mayor Pro-Tem Gorman and Council Member Rouse. Nays: None. Abstentions: None. Motion passed with 3 ayes, 0 nays and 0 abstentions.

Mayor Vardell read the proclamation into the minutes as follows:

*“WHEREAS, On March 14, 2009, at the University of Texas Frank Erwin Center in Austin, the Ponder Lions Boys Basketball Team competed in the State 2A Championship Basketball game against the New Waverly Bulldogs Boys Basketball team; and*  
*WHEREAS, The Lions finished the 2008-2009 basketball season as the Class 2A Basketball State Champions, having beaten the Bulldogs 51 to 39; and*  
*WHEREAS, This outstanding championship basketball team was under the direction of Head Coach Doug Boxell and Assistant Coaches James Holt, Mark Wynn and Steve Young; and*  
*WHEREAS, This athletic accomplishment was supported by enthusiastic teachers, administrators, fans, friends, family, and parents; and*  
*WHEREAS, The Ponder Lions Boys Basketball Team represented the Town of Ponder with the highest level of class; and*

*NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jeff Vardell, Mayor of the Town of Ponder, Texas, do hereby proclaim:*

*APRIL 27, 2009, AS “PONDER LIONS BOYS BASKETBALL DAY” IN THE TOWN OF PONDER, TEXAS AND ENCOURAGE ALL CITIZENS AND SUPPORTERS TO JOIN ME IN CONGRATULATING THE PONDER LIONS, THEIR COACHES, AND STUDENTS OF PONDER HIGH SCHOOL FOR REPRESENTING THEIR SCHOOL AND TOWN IN SUCH A POSITIVE MANNER.”*
